Dear Plaza Families,

May 26th-28th staff will be available from 8:30-2pm to receive school materials. Please turn in Chromebooks, textbooks, library books, classroom materials, sports jerseys, instruments, etc. If you have a cafeteria balance, please drop that off as well. You can also drop off a Spark application and payment.

If there is another parent/student in the classroom, please wait outside. Staff will not be available to have discussions, so please just drop off materials and leave. All student items left in their desks will be bagged and available for pick up.

Families that qualify for free or reduced-price school meals may get \$365 per child in state benefits to buy food. The application is easy so feel free to apply today at <https://ca.p-ebt.org/en/>. You should receive benefits within 10 days. Families who receive a P-EBT card in the mail do not need to apply because the additional benefit is already included.

If you live in another school district, please call your district office to get an interdistrict transfer form for your child(ren). All districts, including Orland Unified, has them available.
