Volunteers for School Functions

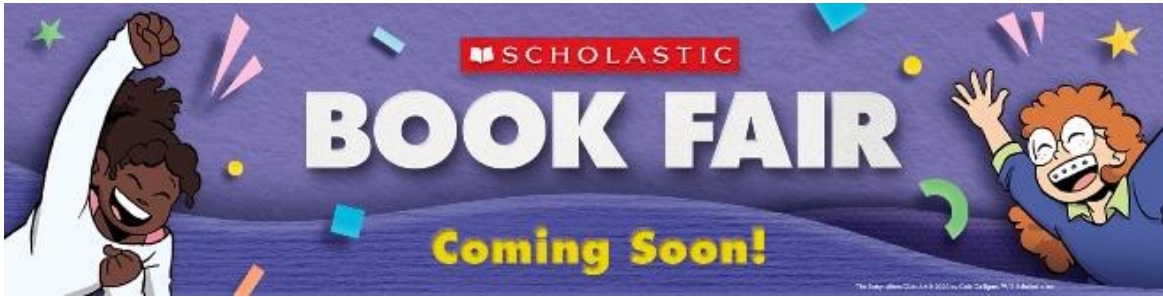
